Your Personalized Path	Consider a minor in Linguistics, American Sign Language, Psychology, Education, Special Education, or Cognitive Science.			

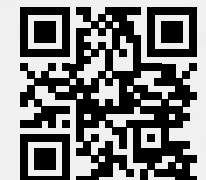
YOU WILL LEARN
