- Nick to provide updates from the Retreat on disposition of Pickens Estate and funding raising status
- Notes from Retreat:
  - Immediate funding needs:
    - Field camp: \$3-6 M
    - Student enrichment: \$20 k/yr, \$500 k endowment
    - Outreach/Summer camp: \$20 k/yr
    - Fix the boat
  - Longer term needs:
    - Truck: \$100-125 k
    - Student lounge: \$2.5-3 k
    - Post doc. Fellowship: \$3 M
    - Professor funding: \$50 k/yr
    - Discretionary fund
    - New chair: \$2-3 M
    - New geoscience building: \$100 M
  - Potential Sources:
    - Battelle outreach program
    - Boone \$3 M endowment (~\$125 k/yr) discretionary fund, student enrichment, and banquet
    - Philanthropete & Orange Giving outreach
    - Alumni events e.g., field trips, short courses
    - Field camp 75 yr celebration associated giving challenges
  - Next steps:
    - Understand endowment agreement
    - Help Dean promote field camp within administration
    - Develop a "road show" to promote field camp (highlight the new facility, describe new and existing activities, create giving opportunities for 75 year celebration)
    - Fall and Spring events to promote outreach
    - Engage students to understand lounge needs and costs
    - Understand boat repair needs
    - Set up monthly capital development committee meetings
