BOOK BINDING OPTIONS AND SETUP



CONSIDERING YOUR OPTIONS

When choosing a style of binding, it's best to make your decision about binding before finalizing your file for print. Depending on your technique, documents will need to be set up in a certain way.

File setup handouts for Saddle-Stitch and Perfect Binding with step by step instructions are available on the VRC website (see link) or log onto the VRC Canvas page with your O-Key.

SADDLE-STITCH BINDING

- Page quantity will need to be in multiples of 4 to prevent blank pages (4, 8, 12, etc)
- Add a bleed of at least 0.25" for more accurate double-sided printing and extend designs to the red bleed lines
- The booklet is spliced into a PDF when saved/exported



PERFECT BINDING

• Add a bleed of at least 0.25" for more accurate double-sided printing and extend designs to the red bleed lines

• Due to the binding process, the center gutter needs to be larger or content will be lost

• Increase the center gutter inside margin to

accommodate the lost area (File>Document Setup>Margin)

• It is recommended that you don't have designs running across the spread

• A detailed VRC handout includes screenshots to help you order and layout your pages

BOOK BINDING OPTIONS AND SETUP



JAPANESE-STAB BINDING

- The VRC does not have a handout regarding file setup for Japanese-Stab binding.
- The file setup is similar to perfect binding.
- This style works best when your pages are single sided

• Margins are most important - A large margin is required on the left-hand side of each page to account for the space where the edge will be bound.



SPIRAL BINDING

• The VRC does not have a handout regarding file setup for spiral binding.

• To setup your file for printing, Save as PDF and export as Pages.

• Staples, FedEx, and other print services in town offer spiral binding services.

• You should be able to disregard file

setup for spiral binding, as pages should be entirely visible (ex: spiral notebooks)

• Spiral binding requires all of your pages be hole-punched, spiral wiring, and a way to thread the wiring through the pages. This can be done with a specialized machine or manually with pliers and a hole-puncher.
