### **Benjamin Gregory Wood Scholarship:**

(1 award per year)

The Benjamin Gregory Wood Scholarship was established by the parents of Benjamin Gregory Wood in his memory. The family requested the funding go to a student who plans to pursue a career related to substance abuse in some way --education, prevention, working with abusers, counseling, etc.

Requirements: Student must be a Sophomore

# Mabel Dixon Looper Scholarship: (1 award per year)

The Mabel Dixon Looper Scholarship was established by the family of Mabel Dixon Looper in her honor; she was the first female to earn a Master's degree in Sociology at OSU.

Requirements: Student must be OK resident, a sophomore, have >3.25 gpa, and preference is given to females

## Richard Dodder Scholarship: (2 awards per year; one undergrad, and one graduate)

Dr. Richard Dodder established this scholarship as a result of receiving the 1995 Oklahoma Medal for Excellence in Teaching at the college/university level from the Oklahoma Foundation For Excellence. This endowment grew to its present level from the many additional, benevolent contributors. The scholarship is given in recognition of excellence and achievement/use of Sociology.

(2 awards per year; one undergrad, and one graduate - plague, no money)

The O.D. Duncan award was established in the name of O.D. Duncan who established the Department of Sociology and Rural Life in 1936 at Oklahoma A&S (OSU). He was chairman of the department until his retirement in 1963.

Requirements: Student must have >3.5 gpa, and preference is given to Seniors.
