



Musician Hearing Health Program

A Collaboration between the OSU Speech-Language-Hearing Clinic
and Greenwood School of Music

OSU now offers a special Musician Hearing Health Program for students and faculty in the Greenwood School of Music! We focus on caring for the ears of future and current professional musicians. Your ears are integral to your work and should be protected.

The program includes:

- **Annual musician hearing screenings for all students and faculty members** (\$25 each).
 - Further diagnostic hearing evaluation is available at our clinic if you do not pass the screening (\$250 and we can file insurance).
- **Over-the-counter musician earplugs.** Multiple styles are available (\$50+ per pair).
- **Custom musician earplugs** (\$250+ per pair).
- **Impressions for custom in-ear monitors** (\$25).
- **Sound-level noise measurements to ensure safe listening levels** and meet OSHA/NIOSH requirements (\$250 per hour).
- **Sound meditation to reduce performance anxiety** (\$250 per hour).

Musicians need an audiologist the way everyone else needs a dentist. Your ears are professional tools—take care of them!
