- 1. Interested students should submit a 250 300 word abstract of original unpublished data to sovereignty.symposium@okcu.edu by March 29, 2024.
- 2. Posters will be judged in separate undergraduate and graduate categories.
- 3. Students of accepted abstracts and must agree to prepare a poster representing the work in their abstract and to be available to discuss their work with visitors during an allocated time at the symposium.
- 4. Successful applicants will be required to register for the symposium as a student attendee.
- 5. More submission details and guidelines for the final poster projects will be made available to confirmed participants.
- 6. A special prize committee will select the best presentation.
