Concerto Competition 2025-2026

The Greenwood School of Music Orchestra Concerto Competition invites all full-time enrolled students to apply with a concerto, aria, or concert piece for soloist and orchestra.

Eligibility

All full-time enrolled GSM students who have not previously been a Concerto Competition winner are eligible to enter the Competition.

Selections must be no longer than 15 minutes in length. A movement or movements of a standard concerto is acceptable.

The work should be suitable for performance by the OSU Symphony Orchestra in terms of instrumentation and difficulty. A full score and parts must be available. If in doubt, consult with Dr. Antonucci before applying.

The Competition

Students must fill out the [application form](#) by November 17th. As part of the application, please upload an unedited video recording with high audio quality of a performance of your selection performed with accompaniment.

Finalists will then be invited to perform their selection live, with accompaniment, during the morning of December 4th in the McKnight Recital Hall (specific times will be assigned). Finalists are responsible for providing their own accompanist.

The Competition will be adjudicated by an impartial panel of OSU faculty. Winners of the final round will be invited to perform with the OSU Symphony Orchestra during the spring semester.
